FRNICPSI01 Picturesque Nice

France's Jewel of the Riviera -- Explore Nice, with its many inviting squares, Old Town, shops and cafes. With your guide, drive along the Promenade des Anglais, overlooked by magnificent palaces. Admire the Palais de la Mediterranee's splendid art deco facade and the neoclassical Negresco hotel. In the Russian district, view St. Nicholas Orthodox Cathedral. Next, ascend Cimiez Hill, home to world-class museums. Pass the Roman baths, Roman amphitheater, and Franciscan church and gardens before continuing along the Boulevard de Cimiez, lined with Belle Epoque villas. Pause at an overlook for sweeping views, then head to the Old Town for a walking tour past the Opera de Nice opera house, the famous Cours Saleya market, baroque churches and Matisse's yellow-hued home. You will have time to wander the maze of narrow medieval lanes before walking back to your hotel. Or choose to stay longer, perhaps enjoying lunch on your own at one of the city's charming restaurants.

An Evening in the City of Glamour and Spectacle -- Enjoy a walking tour through The Rock—the heart of Monaco's medieval quarter—with the spectacular Mediterranean as your backdrop, capping your stroll with dinner in Monte Carlo. Drive with your guide along a picturesque coastal road, passing through Villefranche, Beaulieu and Cap d'Ail. Upon arrival, visit St. Nicholas Cathedral (if the mass schedule permits). Consecrated in 1875, it is the burial site of the royal family, including American actress-turned-princess Grace Kelly. In Monaco's main square, the Place du Palais, pass by the Prince's Palace of Monaco, home to the House of Grimaldi since 1297. Then, continue by coach to Monte Carlo and enjoy a brief walking tour before your elegant dinner at the Cafe de Paris. After, you will have free time. If you wish, you may step inside the world-famous Monte Carlo Casino. Return to Nice via the breathtaking Middle Corniche and admire the coastline, illuminated against the night sky.

Ancient Antibes and Jet-Setting Cannes -- Trace the scenic Cote d'Azur and explore two of its glittering gems during an enriching day along the coast. Drive with your guide from Nice, following the picturesque coastal road past Cagnes sur Mer and Villeneuve-Loubet. Upon arrival in the resort village of Antibes, enjoy a walking tour of the old port, once the heart of the ancient Greek city of Antipolis and today Europe's largest marina. Explore its Old Town, browse the market stalls and see the impressive ramparts. Continue to Cannes via a picturesque inland road. A walking tour leads you to the famous Palais des Festivals, or Film Festival Palace, along the famous Croisette promenade. During the annual gathering of the film industry, celebrities stay in the palatial hotels around you. See the Old Harbor and the Old Town, climbing the stairs to Le Suquet tower for magnificent views of the city and the Lerins Islands offshore.

City of Rome, City of Art -- Experience the celebrated city of Arles (pronounced "Arl"), where remarkable Roman ruins, vibrant colors and a striking quality of light have inspired artists. Upon arrival, you will explore by foot, allowing you to immerse yourself in this energetic city of diverse architecture at the edge of Provence. Begin with a stroll to the massive Les Arenes, an ancient amphitheater able to seat 20,000. Continue to the Antique Theater, peering inside as you pass. This 1st-century wonder stood three stories tall and seated 10,000. Follow the Rue du Cloitre to the Place de la Republique, a bustling square that once hosted the ancient Roman Circus. Here, you will see the 15th-century Church of St. Trophime, a Romanesque triumph named for a 3rd-century bishop. A walk down the Rue de la Republique delivers you to the Espace Van Gogh, the local hospital that treated the artist and today serves as a cultural center.

A Breathtaking Art Show and a Charming Hilltop Village -- See a remarkable multimedia art installation in a former quarry, then ascend to the rock-hewn hamlet of Les Baux. Drive with your guide to the spectacular Carrieres de Lumieres, an art installation space carved into an old quarry. The white limestone from this cave was used to build parts of Les Baux and other surrounding villages. Today, it is a stunning venue for art shows; 2017's innovative exhibit explores the "Fantastic and Wonderful World of Bosch, Brueghel and Arcimboldo." After time to marvel at the rich color and vibrancy illuminated on the quarry walls, continue to Les Baux to explore its dramatic and hilly cobblestone lanes. Take a guided walk here through the picturesque village, a fortified site painstakingly restored, nestled in limestone and crowned by castle ruins. Throughout this rewarding excursion you will traverse the bucolic Provencal countryside, viewing olive groves and rice fields.

The Scents of Provence -- Learn about the legendary lavender that graces the fields of Provence each summer on this enlightening and fragrant full-day tour. Meet your guide and drive into the beautiful countryside of Provence. Stop in the hamlet of Sault to visit a working lavender farm. After a tour and lunch in the village, enjoy a leisurely drive past Ventoux villages and stunning lavender fields. Pause in St. Christol and Simiane la Rotonde to explore and to admire sweeping views of surrounding vineyards and fields. Then, visit Coustellet and the Lavender Museum, founded by a family that runs a vast lavender farm in a nearby village. Dedicated to the beautiful flower's cultivation, distillation and legend, this unique museum features a fascinating collection of objects and exhibits that chronicle its use by perfume makers and by civilizations dating back to ancient Rome. Note: This seasonal tour is typically offered from mid-June to mid-July.

The Remarkable Home of 14th-Century Popes -- Visit the monumental palace that was the seat of seven popes and explore its medieval city. Avignon, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is known as the "City of Popes" because the papacy was relocated here from Rome, to great controversy, from 1309 to 1377. With a local guide, follow the historic center of narrow streets to the Place de l'Horloge, the city's central square, a scene of balconies, elegant facades and shading trees. Continue to the renowned Palace of the Popes for a guided tour. This fortress-church is gigantic, the largest Gothic building of the Middle Ages, dwarfing even the neighboring cathedral. After, continue to the Market Hall for an opportunity to taste olives and pickled garlic. Note: The visit to the Palace of the Popes features many stairs.

Immerse Yourself in French Cuisine -- Indulge your senses and learn to prepare French specialties during this engaging and flavorful culinary tour. Follow the Passage de l'Oratoire to the elegant Rue Saint-Agricol and Rue Joseph Vernet, two famed shopping streets lined with luxurious shops. Stop at La Cure Gourmande, a paradise of confections, chocolates and biscuits. After sampling some of its sweets, continue to Les Delices du Luberon, where savory tapenades and olive oils give you a true taste of the countryside. After, you will visit La Maison de Fogasses for an enriching cooking class. With your Provencal chef, you will prepare the local specialty, fougasse, and enjoy it as a starter. Then, help to make a seasonal entree that you will enjoy later with handmade eclairs, two glasses of local wine and coffee from one of the last French roasters in Avignon. After a satisfying and rewarding meal, return to your ship.

One of Ancient Rome's Great Architectural Marvels -- See the magnificent three-tiered structure built without mortar by Romans 2,000 years ago. One of the most ambitious engineering projects of its time, the Pont du Gard aqueduct carried water to the Roman outpost of Nimes from the springs of Uzes, 31 miles away. It stands today as the greatest legacy of Marcus Vipsanius Agrippa, son-in-law of Augustus. Some of its stones weigh six tons and were lifted as high as 160 feet. You will journey to the aqueduct, which straddles the wooded banks of the Gardon River. Spend time at the site's museum, where you can observe the marriage of modern and ancient at fascinating, interactive exhibits. Then marvel at the huge structure that channeled 44 million gallons of water each day over a tiny gradient of 25 inches per mile for 31 miles. For form and function, it is surely one of the Roman Empire's most breathtaking remains.

Begin your excursion with a stop at Maison Bouachon for a wine tasting. Then, you will continue to the hilltop ruins of the castle, where you can take in sweeping views of the Rhone Valley and Avignon. Stroll or drive down to the charming village it overlooks to meet the vintners whose families have lovingly cultivated these vineyards for generations. They invite you to browse their winery cellars and learn the delicate blending process of their extraordinary wine. Toast your experience by sampling the distinctive bouquet and finish of these very special wines in the place of their birth.

You will stop at the Lavender Museum and see its distillery, where the essential oil is extracted from the flower. You can peruse the botanical garden, collection room and distillation warehouse. Continue to the Ardeche Gorge, one of France's most spectacular natural wonders. Stop to admire this deep ravine, known as the "Grand Canyon of Europe," and see the magnificent Pont d'Arc, a massive natural bridge that spans almost 200 feet across the gorge. Enjoy a guided walk past its medieval houses and colorful gardens and visit its charming castle before returning to your ship.

Along the way, you will also see the smallest cathedral in France, the 11th-century St. Vincent Cathedral, standing meditatively in the town square.

Explore a Rich Roman Past by Trolley and by Foot -- Get to know Vienne and its rich Roman past on a fun and informative trolley excursion and a leisurely walking tour. You will board an open-sided trolley with your guide and enjoy a ride to Mont Pipet. Here, you can enjoy scenic city views and take some time to view the spectacular amphitheater built into the hillside, one of France's best preserved Roman theaters. Your trolley will leave you at Temple Square in the city center. Here, you will admire the Temple of Augustus & Livia, an incredibly preserved 1st-century structure that has only been out of use since the late 19th century. Then visit the enormous Gothic Cathedral of St. Maurice, built over almost 500 years. You can also spend time exploring an old Roman neighborhood, today's Garden of Cybele. Its grounds are dotted with fascinating Roman remains. Note that the order of this tour varies by group.

Part Parisian, Part Old-World France -- See the magnificent highlights of this gastronomic and cultural center. You will begin with a drive to the Basilica of Notre Dame, at the top of Fourviere Hill. After exploring the interior of this spectacular church, enjoy sweeping views of the red roofs of Vieux Lyon (Old Lyon) and the narrow peninsula of land between the rivers comprising the atmospheric Presqu'île shopping district. Next, drive through town past the flamboyant Gothic St. Jean Cathedral and the Palace of Justice, stopping at the city's famed Painted Houses, a breathtaking collection of outdoor murals depicting some 30 of the city's famous figures. Then, continue with a walking tour along the cobblestone streets of Vieux Lyon, where the city's famous traboules, unique hidden passageways made for busy merchants in medieval days, wind through buildings and courtyards. Later, you can shop for souvenirs, perhaps purchasing some of the fine silk for which Lyon is world famous.

Perouges is a treasure of French heritage and culture, the setting of films such as "The Three Musketeers." You will drive with your guide to this hilltop walled town and enjoy a walking tour along its cobblestone streets. As you explore, you will learn about the farmers and linen weavers in this 13th-century communal town that never knew the sway of a lord. Stop at a small museum with glorious alpine views, the local church and the Hostellerie du Vieux Perouges, where you can sample the town's beloved Galette Perougiennne, a sweet pastry served with clotted cream.

Stunning Beauty Complemented by Light Fruity Vintages -- Beaujolais is one of France's most beloved wine regions, and you'll discover why during this flavorful and scenic excursion. In full, it is larger than any one district of its neighbor, Burgundy. Vineyards stretch for four miles along the Saone, and the granite soils and warmer climate make it ideal for growing grapes that produce a light flavor. You will join your guide for a scenic drive through the rolling hills of Beaujolais, where viticulture tradition runs deep. See the legendary Moulin-a-Vent, the windmill that gives its name to one of the most prestigious wines of the region. Then stop at a small museum to learn about the art of winemaking, perhaps hearing about the popular Beaujolais Nouveau and the coveted crus that are produced here. You will also stop at one of Beaujolais's famous cellars to enjoy a tasting with a wine expert.

Irresistible French Delicacies -- Sample the Beaujolais's most beloved culinary treasures during visits to a wine chateau and two working farms. With your guide, drive into the scenic countryside, learning about local agriculture along the way. At the Chateau de Pierreclos, visit the medieval wine cellar for a private wine tasting. Continue to a nearby truffle farm, where you will enjoy a delicious lunch of farm-fresh organic ingredients. Later, watch as the farmer's dog hunts truffles down in the soil. This highly prized fungus has been called "the diamond of the kitchen" for its rich, earthy flavor. Next, stop at a farm renowned for its production of chevre, or goat cheese, a major export in France. Tour the farm with your host and learn how the cheese is made. Then sample both fresh and more mature cheeses, with white wine if you wish. After this full day of French gastronomy, return to your ship.

A Gracious City and a Rich Art Collection Worthy of Dukes -- Take in the splendors of Dijon, a gracious city of welcoming plazas, magnificent Gothic and Renaissance architecture topped with the city's typical multicolored polychrome roofs known as toits bourguignons, and the beautifully preserved Ducal Palace. You will join your guide and head to the classical Ducal Museum, the former royal residence of the Dukes of Burgundy, who once ruled lands stretching from the Mediterranean to The Netherlands. This vast complex was built and enhanced over a 400-year period, with its most recent additions completed in 1737. Today, it houses the city's Town Hall as well as the Musee des Beaux-Arts de Dijon, an excellent fine arts museum that, like the Louvre in Paris, was founded by demand of the people during the French Revolution. At the latter, you might view works by Claude Monet and Jan Brueghel the Elder. Enjoy time to browse before checking in to your hotel.

A Comprehensive and Leisurely Overview -- See the major sights of the romantic “City of Light” with a knowledgeable local guide. You will begin along the famed Champs-Elysees, viewing the Arc de Triomphe, commissioned by Napoleon in 1806 to commemorate his triumphs. Pass many of Paris’s classic highlights including the Palais Garnier opera house; the celebrated Louvre museum and its I.M. Pei-designed glass pyramid entrance; and the Paris Town Hall. Stop at the magnificent Notre Dame Cathedral to admire its Gothic spires and striking facade. Continue into the Latin Quarter, then drive by St. Germain des Pres, Luxembourg Gardens, Musee d’Orsay, Place de la Concorde and the beautiful and recently restored Grand Palais and Petit Palais. See the Les Invalides complex of military buildings, which houses Napoleon’s Tomb and the Ecole Militaire (Military School). You’ll cap off your excursion with an iconic view of the Eiffel Tower from Champ de Mars.

A Parisian Tradition at the Paradis Latin -- Celebrate the colorful tradition of fin de siecle Paris during an unforgettable night out. Transfer to the Paradis Latin in the Latin Quarter, where you take your reserved seats right in front of the stage. The Parisian cabaret was born in the late 19th century during a period of exuberance and progress. Though the Paradis Latin opened in 1803, it burned down and was rebuilt by Gustave Eiffel from 1887–1889, the same period in which he was building his great tower. As Paris grew more vast and impersonal, many Parisians forged a village atmosphere within their arrondissements and came to value unbridled entertainment. This spirit lives on today at Paradis Latin. After an elegant meal featuring Chateaubriand, sit back as an extravagant revue unfolds before you, complete with acrobats, masked dancers, musical comedies, modern ballets and the showstopping French cancan. It’s an evening you’ll never forget.

A Full Day of Burgundy's Wine and Splendor -- Set out into the world-renowned wine country of Burgundy on today's full-day tour. Meet your guide and begin with a drive to the Cote de Nuits; admire the stunning limestone vistas with the distinct terroir that produces the region's fine pinot noir grapes. Continue to the Cote de Beaune, where lighter wines with a more flowery bouquet are made in Beaune, the wine capital of Burgundy. You will have ample opportunities to taste fine vintages when we stop at one of Beaune's famous cellars along the way. Later, you will explore one of the region's most splendid architectural treasures, the Hospices de Beaune Museum. Founded as the Hotel-Dieu to care for the poor and ill after the Hundred Years' War, it remained a hospital until as recently as the 1970s. It is one of the finest examples of French 15th-century architecture, complete with its decorative and colorful polychrome roof.

The Extravagant Home of French Royalty -- Enjoy a day at the former home of French kings, the awe-inspiring Chateau de Versailles. The palace and sprawling gardens, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, began as a small hunting lodge. Over the years it was enlarged by each of its three resident kings—most famously, Louis XIV, the “Sun King.” A local guide will accompany you to the chateau, where you’ll marvel at the extravagance and excess of French royalty. You will see the state apartments of the king, the Hercules Drawing Room with its magnificent painted ceiling, and the famed Hall of Mirrors, the glittering corridor of chandeliers and glass where the Treaty of Versailles was signed to end World War I. You’ll learn about the court life of the 18th century and also see the queen’s apartments and the chamber of Marie Antoinette. Later, there’ll be time to explore the vast, elaborate gardens.
